V International Conference on Applied Linguistics to Foreign Language Teaching: Towards Multilingualism

Nebrija University is pleased to invite you to the *V International Conference on Applied Linguistics to Foreign Language Teaching*, to be held online on June 30th and July 1st 2022.

PRESENTATION

The Conference is designed to be a **meeting point for researchers and teachers, both experts and beginners**, dedicated to teaching and to **contributing to the development and dissemination of new work** in the field of Linguistics, as applied to the didactics of foreign languages

The four languages included in the Conference will be **English, French, German and Spanish**, with a specific panel for each one. The panels will include the following sections: **oral presentations, posters and junior research projects**.

The programme will conclude with a series of **master lectures** delivered by leading international experts in the fields covered during the Conference

 - ITC for FL teaching

 - Design of teaching materials
 - Sociocultural contents and intercultural competence
 - The language portfolio

- Languages of migration and refugees:
 - Acquisition and learning of languages in contexts of migration and refugees
 - Language assessment and certification for migrants and refugees
 - Language teaching for migrants and refugees
 - Design of didactic materials for the teaching of languages in the contexts of migration and refugees

In addition, on the occasion of the V Centenary of the death of Antonio de Nebrija, this year the Conference will host a special panel that will cover the following areas:

- Acquisition, teaching and learning of Spanish as a mother tongue
- Antonio de Nebrija, his work and legacy
- Varieties of Spanish

Communications and posters will be accepted in any of these areas.

OPEN SECTIONS IN EACH LANGUAGE (ENGLISH, FRENCH, GERMAN, SPANISH)

- **Oral presentations:** with a predominantly theoretical content; research results must be connected to the thematic areas of the Conference.
- **Posters:** related to research findings or teaching experiences in the classroom.
- **Junior researchers:** a space for the presentations of end of course projects by students interested in the teaching of foreign languages and in continuing their academic training and research.

CERTIFICATION

Participants will receive a certificate of 20 hours training.

GUIDELINES FOR PAPERS, WORKSHOPS AND POSTERS

Contributions will be presented in the language of the corresponding language panel and will deal with the teaching of the given language (English, French, German, Spanish). No more than two contributions will be accepted by the same author.

Oral presentations should have a predominantly theoretical content and must connect research results into the thematic areas of the Conference. Presentations may be signed by more than one author.

Posters will illustrate both research findings and teaching experiences in the classroom

Junior researchers will present their End of Course Project, followed by a discussion with the audience.

AWARDS

- The author of the best **Final Degree Project** presented at the Conference (according to an Assessment Committee) will be awarded a discount of 50% on a scholarship for the enrolment price in an official Master's degree of the Applied Languages Department in Nebrija University (*Máster Universitario en Lingüística Aplicada a la Enseñanza de Español como Lengua Extranjera, Máster Universitario en Didáctica del Español como Lengua Extranjera, Máster Universitario en Enseñanza Bilingüe para Profesores de Enseñanza Primaria y Secundaria or Máster Universitario en Formación del Profesorado de ESO y Bachillerato, FP y Enseñanza de idiomas*).
- The author of the best **Final Degree Project in relation with the Centenary of Antonio de Nebrija** presented at the Conference (according to an Assessment Committee) will be awarded a discount of 50% on a scholarship for the enrolment price in an official Master's degree of the Applied Languages Department in Nebrija University above mentioned.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

Proposals for presentations, workshops and posters will be examined and, if appropriate, approved for presentation by at least two members of the Scientific Committee. Proposals must include:

- Title
- Type of contribution: presentation, poster or Final Degree Project
- Full name of the author/authors, postal address, telephone and e-mail of the author/authors
- Work or Study Centre
- Abstract (maximum 500 words) where the topic, objectives, conclusions, and references must be explained as clearly and specifically as possible
- Brief CV of the author/authors (maximum 10 lines)

Once a work has been accepted for its presentation at the Conference, at least one of the authors must be registered as a participant, otherwise, the work will not be included. Certificate will not be issued to any author who has not paid the registration fees for the Conference.

PUBLICATION OF PROCEEDINGS

Only papers and posters will be considered for their publication in the proceedings (Congress web page).
